MINUTES

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

A special meeting of the La Grange Liquor Commission was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Liquor Commissioner Thomas Livingston.

Present and constituting a quorum were Liquor Commissioner Thomas Livingston, and Commissioner Mark Kuchler.

Absent: Commissioner Langan

Also present: Assistant Village Manager Andrianna Peterson, and Village Attorney Mark Burkland

2. Approval of the Minutes

It was moved by Commissioner Kuchler and seconded by Commissioner Livingston to approve the minutes of September 28, 2015, as submitted. The motion carried on a voice vote.

3. Liquor License Request Class A-2 / Thipi LLC d/b/a Taco Cantina

Commissioner Livingston asked Assistant Village Manager Andrianna Peterson to introduce the applicant, and to provide an overview of the liquor license application.

The Village has received an application for a Class A-2 liquor license for Taco Cantina at 50 A South La Grange Road. Tarnthip Kunupakarn is the owner and Antonio Soto is the manager. The owner most recently held a Class A-1 liquor license for Omai at this location. Omai has closed and is planned to be rebranded as Taco Cantina, with a full bar. The owner has held a liquor license since 2001 and also operates Thipi Thai restaurant at 25 W. Calendar.

Ms. Kunupakarn indicated that the space formerly occupied by Omai will be repainted and decorated in a rustic theme. The relatively small menu will feature authentic Mexican cuisine which will be available for dine-in, carry out and delivery.

Commissioner Kuchler asked Ms. Kunupakarn if she had any comments from her perspective as a long-term business owner. Ms. Kunupakarn noted that she expects the restaurant to have a significant amount of carry out and that continued enforcement of the 15 minutes spaces is helpful during peak times. She plans to use the same drivers to provide delivery for both Thipi Thai and Taco Cantina.

Commissioner Livingston thanked the applicant for her ongoing reinvestment in La Grange.

It was moved by Commissioner Kuchler and seconded by Commissioner Livingston that the Liquor Commission recommends: (a) that the Village Board of Trustees creates one new Class A-2 Liquor License and (b) that the Liquor Commissioner issues that license to Thipi LLC d/b/a Taco Cantina. located at 50 A South La Grange Road. Motion carried.

Commissioner Livingston stated that the recommendation for approval would be made to the Village Board at its regularly scheduled meeting which may be on November 9, 2015. Ms. Kunupakarn indicated that she may be ready to open as early as October 23. Commissioner Livingston asked Ms. Kunupakarn to work with staff and the Village Attorney to review options related to provisional licensing if necessary.

4. Adjournment

It was moved by Commissioner Kuchler and seconded by Commissioner Livingston that the meeting of the Liquor Commission be adjourned. The motion carried on a voice vote and the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.

- Submit proof of liquor liability insurance coverage of not less than \$1 million (if required by the Liquor Code), including name and address of insurance company for both the licensee and owner of the building in which the alcoholic liquor will be sold for the duration of the license. The Village does not need to be named as an additional insured.
- Submit proof of ownership of the premises for which the license is being sought or a copy of a fully executed lease for those premises.
- Submit a floor plan or drawing that depicts the premises, including the general interior layout and the number of tables and seats.
- Submit proof of completion of a seller and servers training program as provided in Section 111.65 of the Liquor Code.
- Provide a narrative description of the business entity and written business plan that is the subject of the application, including the length

of time each applicant has been in business, nature of that business, and factors which led to the business decision to locate in La Grange.

- Provide Articles of Incorporation (if applicable).
- Submit a \$500 non-refundable application fee or other required fee, as applicable to the license being sought.
- Make an appointment to have fingerprints taken at the La Grange Police Department, 304 West Burlington Avenue, (708) 579-2334. (Note that fingerprint clearance may take 6 to 8 weeks to secure.)

Proceedings After Completion of Application

- Attend a meeting of the La Grange Liquor Commission. The meeting will be scheduled after all information is obtained and reviewed by the Village Manager.

If your application is recommended for approval by the La Grange Liquor Commission, then the application will be presented to the La Grange Board of Trustees for approval. The Board of Trustees meets on the second and fourth Monday of each month at 7:30 p.m. Your attendance at the Village Board meeting may not be required.
- Obtain a State of Illinois liquor license from the Illinois Liquor Commission, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 7-801, Chicago, 60601 (312) 814-2206.
- If your application of a liquor license is approved, then you must pay the applicable license fee in the amount provided in Section 111.25 of the Liquor Code.

Permissible Hours For Liquor Service

The permissible hours of liquor for liquor service are:

- Standard hours: Sunday through Thursday from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following day. Friday and Saturday from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. the following day.
- Classes B, C-1, C-2, D, E, and H: 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. each day unless otherwise specifically provided in the Liquor Code.
- Tastings: 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. each day.





Armand's Victory Pizza

Armand's Victory Pizza is the full service restaurant that is part of Armand's Development Corporation which owns & franchises 10 pizza restaurants in the Chicagoland market. Armand's Victory Pizza is operated by First Course Productions which operates 21 restaurants in the Chicago market, 6 of these restaurants being owned by Anthony Gambino, who is the Principal of First Course Productions.

Armand's Victory Pizza is a full service Italian restaurant based on the original Armand's Restaurant opened in Elmwood Park in 1956. The restaurant features Chicago's best thin crust pizza and other specialty items such as Baked clams, stuffed Artichokes, fried calamari, Anti pasto salad as well as a full menu of traditional Italian entrees and appetizers.

Armand's Victory Pizza also will offer a full sit down bar with 10 stools and a full beer, wine and cocktail menu. This menu will be offered in a full service format with servers and bartenders. While Armand's will offer a full bar the concept remains very much a restaurant with liquor and not a bar.

Location, Concept and Marketing

We feel the Lagrange market allows us to build on the already strong carry-out and delivery business our franchises have built in the last 3 years and expand this into a full service customer. Lagrange is a vibrant downtown which is very similar to other downtown markets we currently have restaurants. These include Elmhurst, Wheaton & Edison Park. These downtowns like Lagrange have strong local concepts mixed with some regional & national brands. We have a proven track record in these markets with over 15 years longevity in Elmhurst.

We also understand the type of local marketing that works in Downtowns which includes direct mail, local newspaper and print which focus primarily on the 3 mile circle around our location. We will also utilize some larger scope marketing such as our online ordering, Groupon and other social media. As a company we utilize a PR agent to maximize our press both locally and throughout Chicago.

Like most suburban downtowns Lagrange has great traffic but limited parking, by offering delivery and carryout we are able to project our business beyond just our four walls and reach customers without them needing to park in the downtown area.

Management

Anthony Gambino has been in the restaurant business for 30 years and also owns Salseria grill & Cantina, HB Jones, Salseria Rapido and is the founder of the Taco Fresco chain which currently has 6 franchised locations.

Ken Patchak who will be the opening General Manager has been with First Course Productions since its beginning and serves as Chief operating officer. Ken has worked with Anthony Gambino for over 25 years and has extensive management experience and is an expert in both full and quick service restaurant operations.

Paul Sciamanda is First Course Productions full service Operations Director and will add this location to the 6 he now oversees. Paul has been in the industry for over 25 years and spent time as a regional director with both Ruth's Chris and Levy Corporation.

Don Greco has been a manager with First course productions for 1 year and opened the first Armand's Victory Tap in Yorktown mall last February and will be involved in training and operations during this opening. Don has over 30 years of experience in the restaurant industry and has opened and run restaurants for Rosebud Corporation, Volare, and owned his own Italian restaurants.

Liquor Policies and compliance (See attached First Course liquor training guidelines)

As a company First course Production employs over 50 certified managers, bartenders and servers. All servers who work for First Course Production must go through the state approved BASSETT liquor program. In addition to this we have all servers and bartenders go through a 1 week training program in which we train and instruct them on proper liquor handling procedures.

We have attached the BASSETT certificates for 3 managers and 3 servers who will be working at the LaGrange location. We will make sure all newly hired employees are also put through the BASSETT program.

Financial Overview (see attached balance sheet)

Anthony Gambino has invested \$400,000 into Victory Pizza Lagrange LLC. This is the company that will own and operate Armand's Victory Pizza. Horvathian Inc the prior owners of

Armand's pizza in Lagrange will retain a 29% ownership in this new company. Their original investment was approximately \$200,000.

This \$400,000 budget for renovation and operations will allow us a \$80,000 budget for operating expenses that include marketing and employee training.

We have included a 5 year Pro-forma and a construction/start-up budget for the restaurant as well as a balance sheet for the corporation.

Alcohol Serving Policy



As a Restaurant that sells alcoholic beverages, we are committed to sensible, socially responsible consumption of alcohol. We help to ensure our customers' and other members of the community's safety by educating our employees on responsible service and management of alcohol. We want our customers to enjoy alcoholic beverages in moderation, but if a customer shows signs of drinking too much, a manager should become informed immediately.

Employees, who serve customers, must abide by the Restaurant's policies on alcoholic beverage service:

1. We will not knowingly allow anyone on our staff that is under the age of 18 to serve alcoholic beverages. No one under the age of 21 may dispense alcoholic beverages.
2. We will not serve alcoholic beverages to an intoxicated person.
3. We will not knowingly serve a person alcoholic beverages to a person under the legal drinking age. It is our policy to card anyone who appears to be under 30 years old.
4. We will offer nonalcoholic alternatives such as soft drinks, coffee, juice, etc.
