MINUTES

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

A meeting of the La Grange Liquor Commission was convened at 6:46 p.m. by Liquor Commissioner Elizabeth Asperger. Present and constituting a quorum were:

Present: Liquor Commissioner Elizabeth Asperger, Commissioner Mark Kuchler, and Commissioner Mark Langan

Absent: None

Also Present: Assistant Village Manager Andrianna Peterson

2. Approval of the Minutes from the Liquor Commission meeting on February 8, 2010.

It was moved by Commissioner Langan and seconded by Commissioner Kuchler to approve the minutes of February 8, 2010, as submitted. The motion carried on a voice vote.

3. Liquor License Request / Liquor License Applicant / La Grange Field Club

Due to a conflict of interest, Commissioner Kuchler recused himself as a voting member on this application.

Commissioner Asperger indicated that Brent Duelm as President of the Board of Governors for the La Grange Field Club is applying for a Class F-2 Liquor License for the La Grange Field Club located at 1314 W. 47th Street. The Class F-2 license authorizes the sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic liquor, by the organization or a licensed caterer, including Bring-Your-Own beer and wine, at four private events in any calendar year. The four private events authorized by a Class F-2 license must be sponsored by the organization and conducted for the organization's members and guests only.

Commissioner Asperger added that the four event limitation does not apply to Bring-Your-Own beer and wine.

Commissioner Asperger noted that liquor control is taken very seriously and it is a privilege to serve liquor in the Village. Commissioner Asperger added that there is no set number of

liquor licenses but rather considered on an individual basis. Commissioner Asperger added that although sellers and servers training is not required it is highly recommended.

Mr. Duelm indicated that the Field Club is restricted to members only and alcohol consumption will be regulated. He also indicated that safety is very important to the Field Club which includes alcohol awareness training.

After discussion, it was moved by Commissioner Langan and seconded by Commissioner Asperger, that the Liquor Commission recommend (a) that the Village Board of Trustees create a new Class F-2 Liquor License and (b) that the Liquor Commissioner issue that license to the La Grange Field Club located at 1314 W. 47th Street.

Commissioner Asperger stated that a recommendation would be made to the Village Board at their next regularly scheduled meeting in May.

4. Other business

Assistant Village Manager Andrianna Peterson updated the Liquor Commission on administrative matters related to the issuance of liquor licenses and anticipated applications for liquor licenses.

5. Adjournment

It was moved by Commissioner Langan and seconded by Commissioner Kuchler that the meeting of the Liquor Commission be adjourned. The motion carried on a voice vote and the meeting was adjourned at 7:16 p.m.
