**Door-To-Door Solicitation** — Door-to-door solicitation is allowed by permission only through the Village Clerk’s office. The first time an agency requests to solicit in the Village of La Grange such request must be approved by the Village Board. Approval does not constitute endorsement of these organizations, their product or services by the Village. (*Exempt: religious, charitable, school, educational, veterans or governmental organizations.*)

Not more than one solicitor is granted permission to solicit on any one day. Solicitors may only operate in the Village of La Grange Monday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. — 9:00 p.m.



All solicitors are required to register at the Police Department each day of soliciting and obtain the Village’s “No Solicitor” list. To be placed on the list, please contact the Village Clerk’s office at 708-579-2316.

Should you have concerns about a door-to-door solicitor, ask that they show their Village solicitor’s permit/authorization and do not hesitate to call the Police Department at 708-579-2333.
