CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Nicor Gas Main Replacement Area Bounded by Ogden, Cossitt, East and Sawyer Avenues



February 9, 2016

Dear Residents and Property Owners:

The Village would like to advise residents that Nicor Gas has submitted plans to the Village to replace gas mains in the area bounded by Ogden, Cossitt, East and Sawyer Avenues. Nicor is replacing aging gas mains and other gas infrastructures in this area as part of an infrastructure improvement program called Investing in Illinois: A Nicor Gas System Improvement Initiative. This work is expected to start this week and be completed over the next several months.

The scope of work will include replacement of aging gas mains, moving meters from the inside of homes to the outside, upgrading storage systems and improving the gas pressure delivery system. Generally, new gas mains and services will be installed on each block and to each home through a process called directional boring. Directional boring is a trenchless technology that reduces the amount of open cut excavation and subsequent restoration. For street openings, Nicor is planning to provide temporary patching with final roadway restoration occurring in the spring when asphalt plants reopen. Additional information regarding the gas main installation and impact on private gas service will be provided to you by Nicor.

Thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation. We will work with Nicor Gas as much as possible to minimize the inconveniences associated with this project.
