	Obey Posted Speed Limits Be mindful of weather conditions, areas of pedestrian traffic, and school zones)  Reduce distractions in vehicles: Use hands-free devices Lower radio volume  Yield to ALL pedestrians (crosswalks or otherwise)  Make eye contact and use hand signals to communicate with pedestrians and cyclists  Share the roadway with cyclists	Use crosswalks (even if they are further down the street from where you intend to cross)  If out for a leisurely walk or exercise, wear reflective or contrasting colors  Do not assume a vehicle sees you or your children  Make eye contact and use hand signals to communicate with a vehicle's driver  Do not be distracted by cellphones or other devices while walking	Stop at red lights and obey stop signs  Travel with the flow of traffic  Wear reflective or contrasting colors  Travel at safe speeds  Do not assume right of way at intersections  Signal turns and lane changes  Make eye contact and use hand signals to indicate your intentions	
		Obey WALK/DO NOT WALK signage	All cyclists are required to follow the same rules of the road as motorists
