The La Grange Police Department is pleased to announce an additional online opportunity for registering closed homes or vacation watches with the Police Department.

Using public safety software available through Frontline Public Safety Solutions (Frontline PSS), residents can now request closed home or vacation watches online. Frontline PSS provides a user-friendly, easily-accessible, and secure way to request a special watch on your closed or vacant home. The Vacation Watch module allows residents of La Grange to create entries of unoccupied or closed homes that they would like the La Grange Police Department to check while the residents are away for extended periods of time. This information becomes available in real-time to patrolling officers – saving both time and resources.

La Grange residents will still be able to request a Vacation Watch in person at the Police Department but are encouraged to try the Frontline PSS Vacation Watch module online.
