Permanent Electronics Recycling Collection Site- A permanent regional electronics recycling collection site is available for residents to recycle electronic waste, which includes computers, office equipment, small home appliances, televisions and home entertainment equipment. For computers, flat screens, projection televisions and monitors, there is a donation fee of \$25 per unit for screens under 21 inches and \$35 per unit for screens over 21 inches. Assistance with unloading the items will be provided and proceeds will benefit the developmentally disabled.

The site is located in Burr Ridge at 451 Commerce Street and is open Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Stone Avenue Train Station Honored with Illinois Preservation Award- Landmarks Illinois has honored the Stone Avenue Train Station with the 2016 Richard H. Driehaus Foundation Preservation Award for Restoration.

Built in 1901, the Stone Avenue Train Station is one of nine projects honored for preservation efforts to save, restore, rehabilitate and reuse historic places in Illinois. The restoration effort restored and stabilized the iconic La Grange landmark, while preserving its turn-of-the-century feel. The project was funded through \$1,085,000 in grants.
