Construction Updates— The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) began the La Grange Road Resurfacing project on April 8. Construction will generally occur between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. throughout the summer, with an anticipated completion date of September 2019, depending on the weather.

The Village is working closely with IDOT and the La Grange Business Association to coordinate the construction project with our downtown signature events this summer and to reduce impacts as much as possible.
