



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

2022 Spring Downtown Streetscape Project

Monday, March 14th, 2022 the Downtown Streetscape Project will begin. Copenhagen Construction will commence with removal and replacement of brick pavers and some concrete sidewalk within the Central Business District (CBD). This Spring project is a first phase. A Fall project will complete the replacement of the remaining CBD brick pavers.

WORK AREAS:

March 14, 2022 - April 15, 2022

- Calendar Ave – Ashland Ave to La Grange Rd (North and South sides of the Street)
- Burlington Ave – Ashland Ave to La Grange Rd (South side of Street)

April 18, 2022 – June 30, 2022

- Burlington Ave – La Grange Rd to 6th Ave
- Hillgrove Ave – Ashland Ave to Beacon Pl
- La Grange Rd – Burlington Ave to Ogden Ave
- E Harris Ave – La Grange Rd to 6th Ave

The Calendar Ave and Burlington Ave segments listed above will be completed first, with all work in these areas expected to be completed by April 15, 2022. Additional resolution on the scheduled work areas after Calendar and Burlington will be provided in future construction updates as work progresses and weather impacts are known.

Paver field replacement will take 1-2 days per location, and should not significantly impact pedestrian traffic due to their proximity to the curb line.

In a few select locations, concrete sidewalk replacement is also occurring. These areas will be marked for removal prior to the start of work. Because of the more intrusive nature of the concrete work, this will generally be done first. Concrete removals, pour, and cure process is expected to take three (3) to four (4) days. Concrete work will be sequenced so that we maintain pedestrian traffic at least on one side of the street at all times and maintain access to all businesses.

Overall, the whole process, concrete and pavers is expected to take one (1) to two (2) weeks per road segment.

Due to the amount of foot traffic within the CBD, we will be taking every measure possible to ensure the safety of pedestrians. There will be ongoing coordination with specific properties in advance of work. The impact to each property should be limited to 1-2 days.

We will work with the contractor as much as possible to minimize the inconveniences associated with this project. The end result will be an improved streetscape that will provide many years of service.
